With her hard studying in March 1989 she earned the prestigious title RIJI, the highest degree offered by the Sogetsu School. She was appointed as the Sogetsu West Coast Regional Director of North America by Headmaster Hiroshi Teshigahara and Mr. Kiri Teshigahara. She was also appointed as the President of Ikebana Teachers Federation in 1997. In 2000 she was appointed as the Director of Sogetsu San Jose-South Bay Branch. She is strongly bounded with the Ikebana community .

Kika Sensei specializes in her unique line and color design that enrich the living and working environments. Kika is a master teaching teacher in Sogetsu School of Ikebana for 53 years.
